Brand New Book \*\*\*\*\* Print on Demand \*\*\*\*\*.The Agriculture and Related Agencies ppropriations bill includes all of USDA (except the Forest Service), plus the Food and Drug Administration and the Commodity Futures Trading Commission. On J une 22, 2006, the Senate Appropriations Committee reported the FY2007 agriculture appropriations bill (H.R. 5384, S.Rept. 109-266). The full House passed its version on May 23, 2006. The Senate-reported bill provides a total of \$94.6 billion, \$691 million (+0.7 ) more than the \$93.9 billion House-passed bill. In addition, the Senate-reported bill includes \$4 billion of emergency agricultural disaster assistance, which does not count against budgetary caps. The House bill has no disaster provisions. The Senate bill provides \$18.2 billion in net discretionary appropriations, \$391 million (+2.2 ) more than the House bill, and is \$1.4 billion above FY2006. Because both bills limit certain mandatory programs, the gross amounts are higher. The Senate s \$18.7 billion gross discretionary subtotal is 1.5 more than the House s \$18.4 billion, and 0.8 above FY2006. About \$76 billion, or about 81 , of both bills is for mandatory programs administered by USDA...
