Gradual, Antiphonal, and Processional will be naturally interpreted of the musical and other adjuncts of solemn worship which the Church uses so freely, and often with so much effect. But the Breviary differs from all these. It is not designed for any particular, sacrament or ceremony, nor for any particular order of the clergy, and not necessarily for public congregational use at all. But it is a book of devotion and instruction for the daily use of all the clergy. The regulations concerning the use of it are both strict and binding. Whoever enjoys any ecclesiastical revenue, all monks and nuns in...
